

WELCOME at ACCOUS!

OUR BRITISH, AMERICAN, and as a general ANGLOPHONE FRIENDS ARE WELCOME AT THE FLYING AREA of ACCOUS.

This area is ruled by the "ACCOUS d'AILES" club. Activities are paragliding and delta.

The official radio frequency for free flight in France is 143.987,5 MHz. This is an emergency frequency. You may use it for your convenience but please don't overload it.

One automatic radio beacon are active at day. It provides infos on the windspeed and temperature each 20 minutes on the free flight frequency: Voice woman => general weather conditions (1660m au "Layens")

A shuttle bus from the club is available at the opening hours. See prices at the place of waiting for the climbs. It may carry up to 8 persons, and not less than 3.

WARNING

- DO NOT FLY when the wind is BLOWING FROM SOUTH, even gently.

- Between twelve and 2 p.m., the valley breeze starts blowing. It may reach a speed of 30-35 KMS/H (near 20MPH). In this case the air is generally bumpy, and the landing approach should be done winward to the landing field, to avoid being backed into the village! - When the valley breeze is established, all south slopes are lee side, thus EXTREMELY DANGEROUS.

- Flying rules and priorities are those prescribed by international air regulations.
